While the school does not represent itself as a Church, we appreciate our heritage as it has helped us define our identity and continues to influence our future.

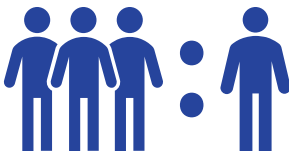
At Lubbock Christian School, students are taught and mentored by excellent educators, and they have the opportunities to become well-rounded citizens by participating in various extracurricular activities.

GRADUATION & HIGHER EDUCATION

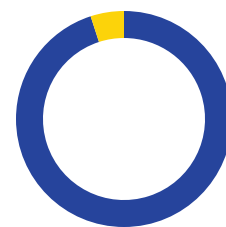
Lubbock Christian School offers a diverse curriculum and provides college readiness opportunities to ensure every graduate is equipped with tools for post-graduation success.

DUAL CREDIT

Dual credit is offered through Lubbock Christian University, Texas Tech University, and South Plains College starting junior year.



TEST PREPARATION

Junior year students can participate in a year-long ACT prep course. The College Advising Coordinator meets with juniors and seniors to schedule ACT and SAT tests.



SCHOOL SELECTION

The College Advising Coordinator meets with juniors and seniors to schedule visits for admissions at the colleges of the student's choice.



FINANCIAL AID SEMINARS

Informational meetings about FAFSA and college scholarships are provided for college-bound students and their parents or guardians.

TO APPLY

Go to LubbockChristian.org to complete an online application. Applications cost \$50 per student. Lubbock Christian School admits students of any race, color, and national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at our school.

After you apply, you will be contacted to schedule an interview with the principal. Following the interview and background check, you will be notified of acceptance and will be emailed a link to begin online enrollment.

DISCOUNTS

- Pre-Payment Discount**
 A 3% deduction from the annual net tuition charge will be granted for accounts paid in-full on, or before, July 15th.
- Family Discount**
 The oldest student in each family pays the full price. The second student will receive a 10% tuition discount, and any additional student(s) in the same family will receive a 20% tuition discount.
- Grandparent Discount**
 This discount is awarded to grandparents with custodial rights to students.
- LCU Discount**
 Full-time LCU employees receive a discount for students in Pre-Kindergarten (4) through 12th Grade.
- Grant Applications**
 Grant applications are available online for 1st Grade - 12th Grade students. Applications must be completed between February 13th and June 30th.

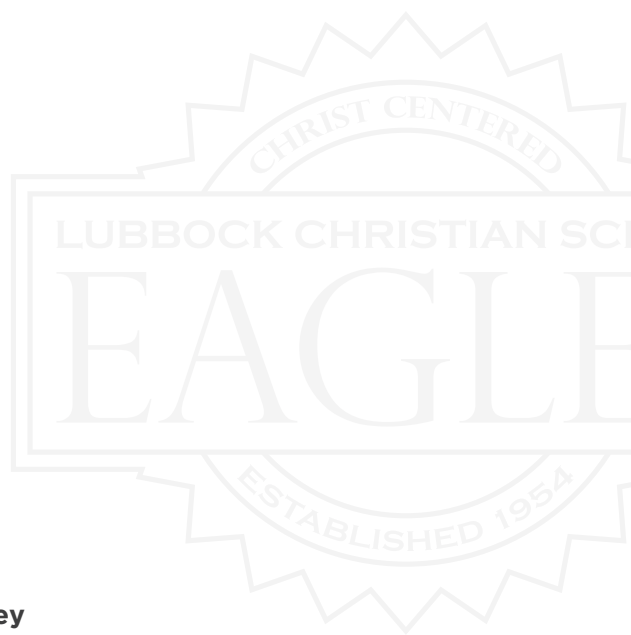
